Attention: Parents/Guardian of Junior Students

Dear Parent/Guardian:

In September 2008, the Roxbury Township Board of Education along with the Roxbury Township Police Department and the Mt. Arlington Police Department mandated the attendance of a parent at the National Safety Council Teen Driver Safety Program (“**Alive at 25**”) in order for a Roxbury High School student to submit an application for a senior parking permit.

Parents’ Classes-Teen Driver Safety Program:

The Parent program complements the four-hour “**Alive at 25**” program that will be presented to all junior health/physical education classes.

The goals of the “**Alive at 25**” program are to:

1. Inform family members about the risks of teen driving based on solid, scientific evidence.
2. Provide practical advice about strategies that the National Safety Council believes may reduce the risks associated with teen driving.
