The Roxbury Woman's Club Scholarship is being awarded to 2 young women who exemplify academic distinction, service and leadership. It has long been a tradition for the club to present a scholarship to a Roxbury High School senior.

I. CRITERIA

- A. This scholarship is made available to female seniors planning to continue their education in junior colleges, colleges, technical/vocational, business or nursing schools.
- B. The applicant's scholarship, character, leadership and service to school and community, as well as financial need, will be considered.

II. INSTRUCTIONS

- A. Please TYPE or PRINT legibly. Answer as accurately and as honestly as you can. What you say will be considered confidential. Complete all sections of this application.
- B. Be sure to request the Guidance Office to attach a copy of your grades and class standing.
- C. Deadline: Your application is due in the Guidance Office on or before **MARCH 22, 2010**.
- D. Semifinalists MAY be expected to attend one or more interview sessions to be determined at a later date.

III. SELECTION PROCEDURE

- A. A general announcement will be made by the Guidance Department to inform the students of the scholarships available through this application.
- B. Applications will be available through the Guidance Department. The Guidance Department may review and verify applications, and make applicable comments if requested by the organization.
- C. The decision of the scholarship committee is final. If for some reason the recipient cannot use the scholarship, the organization must be notified and reserves the right to choose an alternate or to re-offer the scholarship the following year.

IV. PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP

- A. The entire amount is paid at the beginning of the freshman year unless otherwise specified in the scholarship description.
- B. Residency or family membership requirements do not apply unless stated in the scholarship description.
