- A. A general announcement will be made by the Guidance Department to inform the students of the scholarships available through this application. Additional publicity will be issued by the individual organizations. A separate application is available for each of the following Local Scholarships: Roxbury Rotary Club, Roxbury Education Association Philanthropic Fund, Roxbury Kiwanis.
- B. Applications will be available through the Guidance Department. The Guidance Department may review and verify applications, and make applicable comments if requested by the organizations.
- C. The decision of the various Scholarship Committees is final. If for some reason the recipient cannot use the scholarship, each organization must be notified, and in turn, each organization reserves the right to choose an alternate or to re-offer the scholarship the following year.

- B. Residency or family membership requirements do not apply unless stated in the Scholarship Description.
