




The following pages highlight some of the features in Major Clarity that will help you find a college or university that meets your individual needs.


College Search:







Requesting Teacher Evaluations for Common App:

Click on Add Teacher to add a teacher to your list of teacher evaluators. Then start typing their name and select their name from the list of teachers. Then click **"Save"**.

To request the teacher send an Evaluation to a school click the "Edit" button beside their name.

Then click the "Add" button next to the school you would like them to submit an evaluation to. You will see the number of teachers assigned/required next to each school and will see a blue check mark next to each school the teacher is assigned to.
