Teacher's Report- EMS Report by Mrs. Richman & Mrs. Rodas:

- On 11/6/19 a Veterans Day Assembly took place in the auditorium. Invited guest veterans, Roxbury Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts and EMS participating students helped to make it welcoming and special.
- On 10/11/19, 'Read In Day' took place in the hallways and rooms of EMS. It was a great success and was featured on News 12!
- The 7th Grade Class went to see Edgar Allen Poe at the Pax Amicus Theater.
- Starting this school year, three 7th grade teacher advisors and three 8th Grade teacher advisors (for 8th grade they are Mrs. Blewitt{Team 8-2}, Mrs. Richman{Team 8-1} and Mrs. Rodas{Team 8-3}) will work as liaisons collaboratively with their grade student body in a pilot wellness program that centers on fostering good student 'team member' life skills and abilities during their brief two years at EMS. This will better prepare them for their 4 year high school/tech school experiences that occur outside the actual academic classroom. They will learn about group unity, individual identity and positivity, developing good friendships and good study skills, etc. A student lead area will be created in Google Classroom for each grade group to use for communicating once a month or as needed.
- The 8th Grade Class Breakfast will occur in the EMS Cafeteria on the school day morning of Tuesday, 6/23/20 (early dismissal half day of school). During the breakfast(tentative), Team Awards will be given out, yearbook signing, a memory walk and maybe a year-in-review video will be shown. There will be approximately 270 students and 30 faculty staff members in attendance. After the breakfast, the class will walk over to the Roxbury High School to practice for the evening's Set Up Ceremony.

- The 8th Grade Class will be going to see Romeo and Juliet at the Pax Amicus Theater on April 20, 21, or 22(Teams TBD). Also, they will be going on a 8th Grade Class Trip to Jeff Lake. A flyer, outlining the three 8th grade events and the two payment plan options, will be handed out before the holiday break.
- The EMS Reading Train Program is going well. There are 7 classes participating (3-7th grade, 3-8th grade, and 1 hybrid class) and there is a once a month gift card drawing based on completed reading books.
- The teachers suggested that the PTO create an award to be given out at the Set Up Ceremony to a student who exemplifies a particular attribute (including kindness, etc).

President's Report:

- Easiest-Ever Fundraiser(Ongoing): {\$7 membership dues and \$13 donation= \$20} The \$7 membership dues allows students free admission into the 2 Fun Nights (Fall and Winter). Students can sign their family up to the PTO right at the entrance door as they enter the Fun Night. Children of supporters will attend the fun nights free of charge. There will be an admission fee for non-supporters. An accurate, up-to-date dues/donation spreadsheet will be maintained by the PTO treasurer and will be present at each event.

- 1) The Fall Fun Night on Friday, November 15, 2019 from 7-9pm
- 2) The Winter Fun Night on Friday, February 7, 2020 from 7-9pm

Both of the above fun nights are for 7th and 8th grade students attending EMS~ parent donated snacks/drinks are set up in the lunch room & the gym is divided into two sides: one side for volleyball and the other side for a DJ playing music- on the Wed. or Thur. before the fun night, PTO volunteers will be selling tickets near or in the lunch roomparents can sign up for the PTO by having their children pay the supporter dues then, or else an admission fee will be charged at the door.

For the Fall 11/15/19 and the Winter 2/7/20 Fun Night: A Sign Up Genius will go on both the EMS Parent and EMS PTO Facebook pages to ask for volunteer help. The PTO will purchase new volleyballs from Walmart to use on the one half of the Gym. Eighth grade student Tyler Benedetto will be the D.J. for the evening. There will be a variety of games in the cafeteria that the students can play throughout the night.
