XI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Superintendent, Mrs. Loretta Radulic, reported the following:

- I'd like to briefly address the Eisenhower Middle School graduation. There were certainly beautiful
 moments that night that were marred by unacceptable and unkind comments and inappropriate
 behavior. I want our community to know that we are investigating the matters and will look to
 address them.
- Thank you to Board members for the beautiful signs for the class of 2020. Special thanks Kathy, Anne and Leo. Roxbury High School Virtual high school Graduation video went live this evening at 4pm. Well done, Mr. Miller, Mr. Zegar, and Dr. Seipp. It was certainly a wonderful tribute to the special class of 2020.
- In the correspondence sent to the Board, there were a number of action items as already mentioned by Ms. Scheneck. Action items included reviewing the District's Code of Conduct and policies. providing resources for staff and family members, and continued education/training for staff and students. To be sure, we are already in the process of reviewing the Code of Conduct and policies. In addition, our principals and guidance counselors do provide resources for staff and family members to help guide difficult conversations that address race and promote inclusivity. As I mentioned in my report at the last board of education meeting, we also have two clubs that serve to address the mission of inclusivity: PRISM and ERA (Equal Rights Advocacy). In my reply to Rox4Change, I suggested meeting so that I could help bring together our community and club members. I sincerely hope that they will take me up on the offer. Just to share, ERA was a trial club for two years, as is our policy, and was formally adopted on May 11th. Our Equal Rights Advocacy club has 38 members and have covered a plethora of topics, such as misconceptions of feminism, minority representation in politics, walk for water, equal rights amendment, gender implications, wage gaps, anti-Semitism, sexual misconduct, censorship, and more. In addition, our LGBTQ students provided a presentation to our educators to build stronger opportunities for communication and discussion. Regarding curriculum and materials written by people of color, we have a wide selection that is not new to Roxbury. We seek to support all individuals. This can be a more detailed conversation and again, I welcome a meeting where this can be discussed. In addition, we have strong HIB policies and practices to address prejudice and bias. I am also proud to announce that we successfully passed QSAC where we demonstrated that our curriculum includes all races, gender, sexual identities to support an inclusive humanity. In addition, we have adopted an inclusivity statement to be used for identification of curricular resources. While we don't have a Diversity administrator, we take it as every person's responsibility to support all of our students. To that end, our Director of Research has been working with Stephanie Harris from the Amistad Commission for the past year. She has stated that Roxbury is far ahead of other districts and we are rich in representing all populations and we are beginning conversations with Melinda Mangan from Rutgers on supporting administrators' conversations with teachers to support our transgender students, (that was unfortunately cut short due to the pandemic). We are also in the process of designing an Inclusivity Committee that was recently discussed at both the Board's Policy and Education committees.

- If you haven't listened to Roxbury High School Classic Sounds Virtual Choir 2020 perform "Afternoon on a Hill" by Eric Barnum. Do it! Of course, you run the risk of getting pulled into all of their performances which are equally brilliant.
- I'd like to take a moment to offer best wishes to this year's retirees, safe summers for all of our students, and congratulations to our 2020 seniors. It's been a wild ride these last few months, but Roxbury has remained strong, resilient, compassionate, and proud. Thank you, staff, parents, administrators, board of education members, township leaders, and most of all students.
