Memorandum of Agreement between Roxbury Board of Education &

Roxbury Education Association

The Roxbury Board of Education and the Roxbury Education Association agree to the following changes to the current collective bargaining agreement, subject to ratification by the parties.

- 1. 3-year term (July 1, 2023 June 30, 2026). All dates in the contract shall be adjusted to reflect duration.
- 2. Increases to All Salary Guides, except Paraprofessionals' guide, (inclusive of increment):
 - a. Year 1: 2023-2024 3.30% of the 2022-2023 base
 - b. Year 2: 2024-2025 3.40% of the 2023-2024 base
 - c. Year 3: 2025-2026 3.40% of the 2024-2025 base
- Paraprofessionals guide: Guide created and agreed upon by the parties for all three years of the contract, formal documents to be created and signed, and will be considered as part this memorandum of agreement once signed. See attached
 - a. The parties have agreed that nine veteran paraprofessionals will be credited for past years where they were frozen on the guide. Transition chart has been discussed to be formatted and signed, and will be considered as part of this memorandum of agreement once signed.
- 4. Increases to Appendix E: Extra-Curricular and Athletic Salary Guides:
 - a. Year 1: 2023-2024 1.50% of the 2022-2023 base + \$4,000 for guide improvement
 - b. Year 2: 2024-2025 1.50% of the 2023-2024 base + \$4,000 for guide improvement
 - c. Year 3: 2025-2026 1.50% of the 2024-2025 base + \$4,000 for guide improvement
- 5. All signed Tentative Agreements previously agreed upon during the course of these negotiations will be part of, and attached to, this memorandum of agreement. These tentative agreements are:

 - TA #1 signed 3/27/23 and updated on 5/25/23 for stipend amounts.

12. Longevity: Article XXXVI- C

Delete the following language:

Any teacher presently employed with eleven (11) or more years of service as of September I, 1984, shall be eligible for the following additional service increments: \$200 after 15, 20, 25, 30, 35, and 40 years,

Any teacher presently employed with ten (10) years or less of service as of September 1, 1984, and any teacher newly employed for the 1984/1985 school year and after, shall not be eligible for additional service increments.

A teacher that does not meet full certification requirements may be salaried \$200 less, or one step lower on the guide.

Effective July 1, 2023 employees will receive the following longevity amounts based upon completed years of service in the Roxbury School District. These shall be paid in equal installments with the regular paychecks.

TENTATIVE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT NO. 1 (TMA #1) FOR THE SUCCESSOR AGREEMENT TO THE 2020-2023 AGREEMENT BETWEEN ROXBURY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND ROXBURY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION

<u>This tentative Memorandum of Agreement is made on this</u> <u>day of</u> 2023 by and between the Roxbury Board of Education ("Board") and the Roxbury Education Association ("Association") negotiations committees.

The parties have engaged in negotiations in an effort to arrive at a successor agreement to the current Agreement between these same parties which expires on June 30, 2023. In such effort, the parties wish to reduce to written record the partial progress achieved in reaching tentative agreements on several matters while negotiations continue on other matters.

Now, Therefore, the parties stipulate agreement to the following changes to the current Agreement for incorporation into the successor agreement subject to ratification of all terms and conditions as contained in this and future tentative Memorandum of Agreements.

1. Article XIII Transfers and Assignments

A. Teachers

1. Voluntary Transfers and Assignments

b. A list of vacancies within the school system shall be posted in each building on the District website and via email to all employees periodically on the basis of resignations or Board approval of hiring additional personnel. Such vacancies shall be posted expeditiously to afford staff a reasonable opportunity to apply for said vacancies. All teachers making application shall have the receipt and perusal of their application acknowledged by a form letter or card from the Superintendent or his/her designee via email. When vacancies

occur during the summer the President of the Association (or the President's designee) shall be notified by email. Consideration shall be given to qualified employees already employed by the Board.

c. Teachers who desire a change in grade level and/or subject assignment or who desire to transfer to another building may file a written statement *via email or* other written communication of such desire with the superintendent before February 1. Such statement shall include the grade level and/or subject to which the teacher desires to be assigned and the school or schools to which he desires to be transferred in order of preference. All teachers shall be notified in writing or via email by the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee of the status of their request for transfer or reassignment prior to May 30th to the extent known.

2. Involuntary Transfers

c. Date of posting — Whenever a vacancy occurs, a notice shall be posted for five (5) *school* days and remain posted in each school on the District website until the position is filled. A copy of said notice shall be given to the Association at the time of posting *and sent via email to all employees*. Secretaries or paraprofessionals who desire to apply for such vacancies shall submit their applications in writing or via email to the superintendent within the time limit specified in the notice.

2. Article XIV - Promotions

A. Teachers

2. Vacancies in such promotional positions shall be posted in each school building on the District website and sent via email to all employees at least ten (10) five (5) schools days before the final date when applications must be submitted.

3. Teachers shall submit their application in writing or via email to the Superintendent within the time limit specified in the notice, and the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee shall acknowledge in writing the receipt of all such applications via email.

Teachers shall submit their application via email or other writing to the

Superintendent within the time limit specified in the notice and the Superintendent or the

Superintendent's designee shall acknowledge the receipt of all such applications via email.

Tentative Agreement between the Roxbury Board of Education and the Roxbury Education Association

ARTICLE XLVII VACATIONS

- A. The Employer agrees to grant to all twelve (12) month employees in the bargaining unit paid vacations in accordance with the following schedule:
 - 1. If employed on or after May 1, no vacation can be earned through the end of the school year. If employed before May 1, one (1) vacation day will be granted for each ten (10) weeks of service during the school year. If initial employment commences after July 1, during the first school year of employment vacation shall be granted at the rate of .83 vacation days per each full month of service during the school year. The school year shall be defined as beginning on July 1 and ending on June 30.
 - 2. For the purpose of calculating vacation time, July 1 shall be considered the anniversary date of all employees. The number or years accumulated shall be determined by the employee's date of hire. For example, an employee hired between July 1 and December 31, 1991, shall have a five (5) year anniversary date of July 1, 1996. An employee hired between January 1, 1992 and June 30, 1992, shall have a five (5) year anniversary date of July 1, 1997.
 - 3. Two (2) weeks of vacation up to five (5) years of service within the system, three (3) weeks of vacation after five (5) years of service within the system. Thereafter one (1) additional day of vacation will be added for each additional year of service up to fifteen (15) years of service at which time the employee shall be eligible for five (5) weeks of vacation. Effective July 1, 2007, vacation days shall not be rolled over from one year into the nexts Vacation days which are not utilized will be forfeited.
 - 4. Vacations may not be taken the week before school closes or the two weeks before it opens.

ARTICLE XV

LEAVE POLICY AND LEAVE POLICY BENEFITS

A. Sick Leave

All unit employees employed on a ten (10) month basis shall be entitled to ten (10) days sick leave per year with pay. After fifteen (15) years of service, all employees employed on a ten (10) month basis will receive thirteen (13) sick days per year. Employees employed for more than ten (10) months shall be compensated one (1) day for each additional month. Unused sick leave days shall be accumulated from year to year with no maximum limit.

- I. For new Paraprofessionals hired as July 1, 2023, and contracted for less than five (5) work days in the regular five (5) day work week:
 - The "(10) days" and "(13) sick days" entitlement on a 10-month basis listed in the above paragraph will be adjusted to the entitlement amount shown in the charts below, and all other provisions of the above paragraph will remain unchanged. A "work day" for the purposes of this adjustment is defined as working any number of hours in a given day.
 - Should the employee's contracted schedule be changed during the course of the work year, the schedule that is comprised of the greater amount of work days in the regular five (5) day work week will be utilized to determine the entitlement for the total number of sick days for the entire work year.
 - Employment contracts issued to the employees will detail the number of work days per regular five (5) day work week, and will be made available to the Association upon request.
