NEW JERSEY'S STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM

- 2024 marks the 8th administration of the revised assessment instrument in New Jersey
 - 4 years - Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC)
 - 4 years - New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA)
- NJSLA was not administered in the spring of 2020 or 2021.
- Students participated in NJSLA English Language Arts and Literacy Assessments (ELA/L) in grades 3 – 9 and NJSLA Mathematics Assessments in grades 3 – 8 and Grade 9 (Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II) and grades 5, 8, and 11 for Science

- Moving into year three of implementation of the **Supplemental Curriculum Series'** (Reveal Math for General Education & Number Worlds for Special Education and Tier 3 Students in ISL program.)
- Grades **K-8 Scope & Sequence updated** to better align to standards and development of mathematical concepts.
- Teacher committee revised Unit/Standards-based assessments June 2024
- K - 5 curriculum updated to match new NJSLs - Summer 2024
- Focus on increasing students mathematical reasoning skills: **Professional Development/Training-** Instructional Strategies with Denis Sheeran and Eric Milou
- **Deconstruction of Standards** based on **DOK levels** with training and support in K-8 PLCs
- Introduced full time ISL teacher to support tier 2 and 3 interventions in 7-8
- **Identifying standards** on classroom assessments 9 - 12 and infusion of released items from NJSLA and NJGPA.

How do we continue to respond and grow?

■ ELA:

- **Wilson Foundations** scope and sequence now matches recommended grade level pacing in grades K-3
 - Grade 3 completing Level 2 and teaching complete Level 3
 - **Fun in Focus Foundations Intervention** Program in grades 1-2
- **Heggerty Phonemic Awareness** program taught daily in grades K-1 and new Heggerty decodable texts
- **Word Wisdom** vocabulary program and new **Grammar** lessons in grade 4
- **Writing Labsite trainings** with Leah Steiner for small group & tiered instruction
- Fluid, data driven **early intervention reading** with support from NJTSS_ER and **DIBELS 8** now administered K-3 district-wide
- Staff development for teachers 7-12 developed with teacher input and aligned to areas for growth
- Data meetings in 7-12 PLC's to identify and calibrate instructional goals
- Introduced full time ISL teacher to support tier 2 and 3 interventions in 7-8
- Conferring models for specific, individualized, timely feedback introduced during 9-12 staff development

How do we continue to respond and grow?

■ SCIENCE:

- **Collaboration** with K-6 ELA, 7-12 ELA, 7-12 SS, and 7-12 Science supervisors to unpack evidence statements and identify curricular moments to teach into targeted areas for improvement.
- Targeting ELA standards on **teacher SGO's 7-12** and on standards-based grading assessments
- Auditing **standards on summative assessments 7-12**
- Integrating assessment questions into instruction using **language and formats similar to those found in the NJSLA-S.**
- 7-8 Humanities collaboration to create a common rubric for writing assessment
- 7-8 ELA Staff development has spent two years focused on reading workshop; we are transitioning to writing workshop to address writing scores.
- **Increased volume of student reading and writing** expectations 7-12
- Introduced 7-8 ISL program in ELA and Math this year to support struggling students with student-specific, data-driven instruction on pre-requisite skills

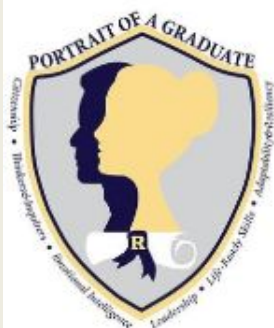
