

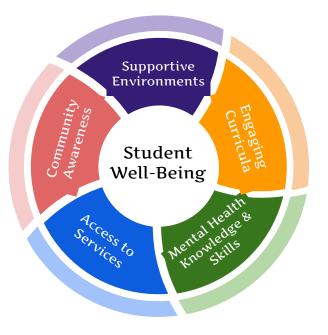


District Goal 4- Health & Wellness
